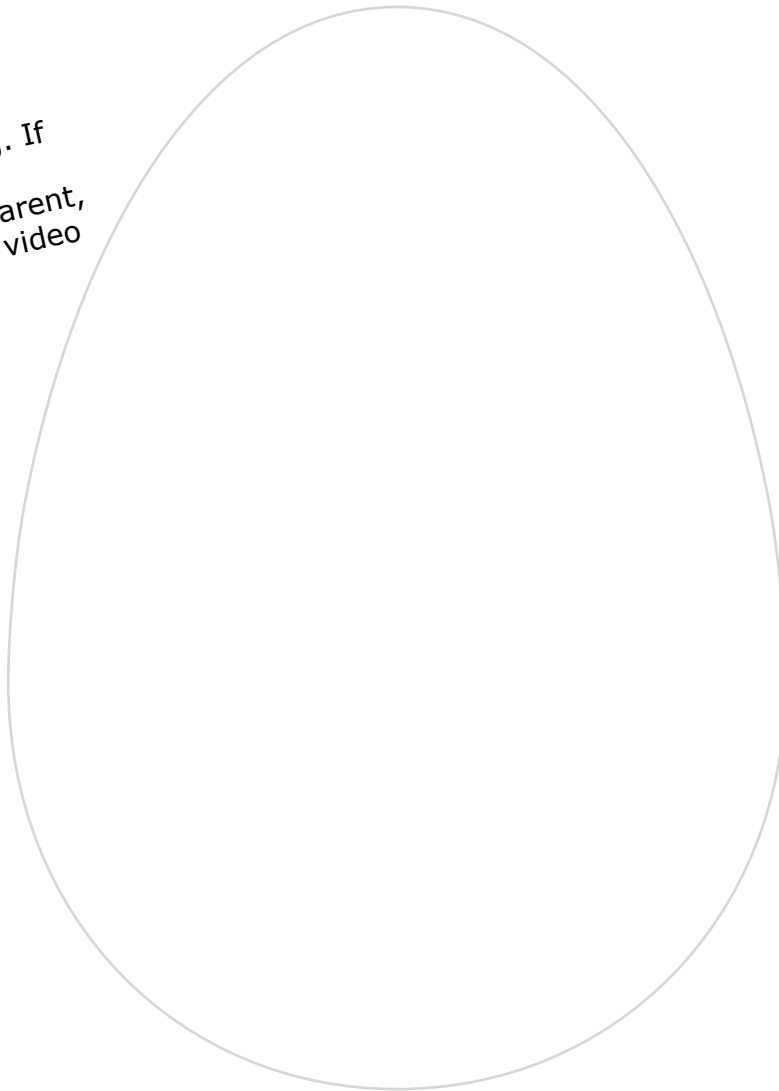
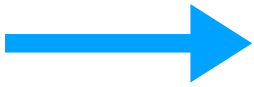


Beatrix Potter Teatime Book Club—Wk 4

Decorate Jemima's Egg

TRY THIS—

Add a clever piece of alliteration to your egg. If you don't know what alliteration is, ask a parent, or watch our Week 4 video of the Beatrix Potter Teatime Book Club.



Decorate one of Jemima Puddle-Duck's eggs. Here are some ways to make it fun:

1. Use crayons, colored pencils, paint, or markers.
2. Decorate them by using the pigment from flowers; this process is called flower pounding. Pick a few flowers that are colors you would like to see on your eggs. Place the petals on your egg templates in a pattern that you like, and then take a round rock and gently "pound" the petals to get the pigment of them onto your egg.
