
Beatrix Potter Teatime Book Club—Wk 3 Mrs. Tiggy-Winkle's Washing



Mrs. Tiggy-Winkle was always busy washing items from neighborhood critters. She washed waist-coats, tablecloths, stockings, and the like. Design a 'washing day' page in your notebook by placing washed items on a clothesline. Here are some ways to make it fun:

- 1. Draw a background—trees, grass, far-away hills, and whatever else you can imagine, but leave room in the middle of the page for the clothesline and washed items.
- 2. Make a clothesline—either draw it, or make it stand out, using thin string and popsicle sticks, toothpicks, or small twigs.
- 3. Add the washed items—draw your own, or use the pictures on this page. You can cut these items out and color them, or use them as stencils to trace onto other paper with fun designs or scraps of fabric and cut out. Once your items are ready, glue them to the clothesline.
