

# Beatrix Potter Teatime Book Club—Wk 6

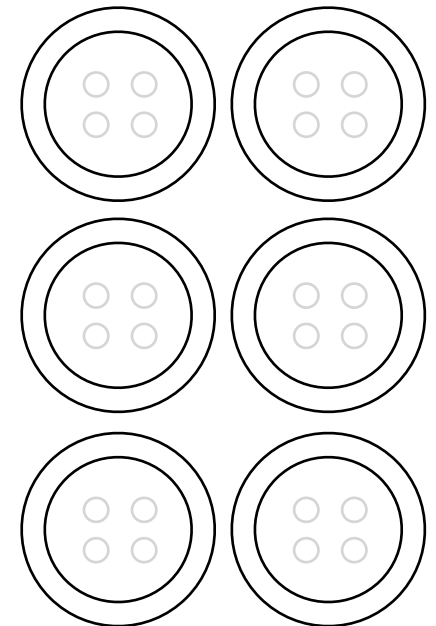
## Tom Kitten's Buttons (Onomatopoeia)

1. Cut out the vest along the dotted lines.
2. Glue the blank side to your notebook.
3. Fold the each vest side in, and design them with colored pencils, markers, etc.
4. Write a different example of onomatopoeia in each large button. (Eek, pop, etc...)
5. Glue the buttons inside the vest. Now Tom Kitten won't run out of buttons!

**What is onomatopoeia?**  
It is a word that imitates the natural sound of the thing described.

Examples:  
pit, pat, paddle pat;  
hoo, hoo; pop, etc...
